


REALITY CHECK ON VOTING RECORDS

In 2010 Legislative Democrats have killed virtually every Republican jobs bill, and actually introduced 39 new job killers.

Assembly Democrats average a failing grade of just 12 percent on the NFIB scorecard and 26 percent on the Cal Chamber scorecard.

The highest Democrat score on the NFIB scorecard was just 44 percent.

Just 3 Democrats had a score of higher than 50 percent on the Cal Chamber scorecard.
