I am writing in support of AB 269, which would give military personnel and families living outside of the United States three extra days for their ballots to be received by local elections officials; allowing for much needed extra time for their votes to be counted.

Data from recent elections shows that the majority of late ballot returns received were from military personnel, often due to slow mail delivery or combat zone duty. Under current law these ballots are disqualified. AB 269 would require that these ballots are counted, as long as they are postmarked on or before Election Day.

Let's honor the service and sacrifice of these brave men and women and ensure that their votes are counted.
