**2014 Legislative Bill Package**

**AB 2036: Toll Facilities**

This bill will require a two thirds majority vote of an affected area for the construction of a toll facility. Currently, government bureaucrats and transportation bodies have the authority to construct toll facilities and although there are opportunities for public comment, there is no decision making authority for the people within an affected area.

**AB 2335: Unlicensed Rehabilitation Homes**

A residential rehabilitation home, also known as a Sober Living Homes, for alcohol and substance abuse can be currently unlicensed if there are six or fewer residents within a home. This proposal clarifies characteristics of a Sober Living Home such as not providing certain contractual medical services that will help distinguish the blurred line between a recovery facility and medical provider.

**AB 2374: Rehabilitation Homes Reporting Requirements & Counselor Oversight**

This bill codifies death reporting requirements in state law and requires the department approved certifying organizations of alcohol and drug counselors to consult with each other and the National Practitioner data Bank to determine whether a counselor has ever had his or her license or certification revoked.

**AB 2628: OCERS**

This bill will amend a provision of the County Employees Retirement Law (CERL), applicable only to Orange County, to permit an alternate for the Board appointed members.

**AB 2433: Catastrophic Coverage**

This bill will allow individuals over 30, for this year only, to have catastrophic coverage without penalty under provisions of Covered California.

**AB 2277: Legislative Transparency Act**

This bill will require the office of Legislative Counsel of California to provide a complete voting record for each member of the legislature, which can be downloaded into a spreadsheet accessible to the public.
