Who is Assemblymember Waldron?

Assemblymember Waldron represents nearly half a million constituents of Assembly District 75 which encompasses North County San Diego and South Riverside County. Prior to being elected to the State Assembly in 2012, Assemblymember Waldron served as an Escondido City Councilmember from 1992 – 2012. In addition, Marie and her husband, Steve Waldron, have owned and operated Top End Tees Screen printing and Apparel in Escondido for 20 years. Marie also has a B.S. degree from St. John's University and has done graduate work at UCSD and SDSU. She currently resides in Escondido with her husband and has one 13-year old son.

Why should you intern for Assemblymember Waldron?

This is an amazing opportunity to get involved with the legislative process, get real life work experience, and get a head-start on your career. In our office, interns have the opportunity to work in a professional environment, build one's resume, and network with elected officials, business owners, and community leaders.

What will be required of Assemblymember Waldron interns?

Interns will perform a variety of tasks geared towards assisting both the legislator and her staff. Potential tasks include but are not limited to constituent correspondence, canvassing neighborhoods, research projects, maintaining and operating databases, working with government agencies, public appearances, public speaking, and administrative assistance for the office. Furthermore, interns must have reliable transportation and be willing to travel within the district.

A minimum of 3 months or 125 hours is required. Weekly scheduling is flexible for all interns. A letter of recommendation from the Assemblywoman may be earned upon completion of the program and paid internships are a possibility when positions are vacated.
